



Good Faith Estimate Notice

Notice to All Current and Prospective Patients:

Effective 1/1/2022, pursuant to the No Surprise Act (HR 133, Title 45 Section 149.610), health care providers will need to issue Good Faith Estimates (GFE). This is an estimate of expected charges for medical services including psychotherapy for a 12 month period. This will be given to patients who do not have insurance, or who are choosing not to utilize their healthcare benefits.

You have the right to receive a Good Faith Estimate (GFE) for the total expected costs of therapy. This is only an estimation of your care and additional treatment and costs may be identified in the future. If this occurs, you will be given an update GFE.

If you receive a bill for at least \$400.00 more than the GFE, you may dispute the bill. You have 120 days from the date of the bill to appeal and you will need a copy of the bill.
